



Excerpts from the Rules & Bye Laws of the Club relating to Junior Members

10.6 JUNIOR MEMBERS

- 10.6.1 **Junior Members** shall be over the age of 11 years and under the age of 18 years on 1st January in the subscription year.
- 10.6.2 **Junior Qualified Members** shall, in the case of male members hold a handicap of 19.9 or less and in the case of female members hold a handicap of 39.9 or less. The Green Committee shall decide, from time to time, access and times of access to adult competitions for Junior Qualified Members
- 10.6.3 **Junior Academy Members** shall be over the age of 9 years on 1st January in the subscription year and shall be deemed by the Junior Convenors to have the necessary golf skills to be an Academy player.
- 10.6.4 **Junior Cadet Members** shall be over the age of 9 years on 1st January in the subscription year.

12.3 JUNIOR MEMBERS

- 12.3.1 Junior Members who will be age 18 before 1st January in any year may transfer to Ordinary Intermediate A Member. The Main Committee reserves the right to refuse such a transfer without explanation.
- 12.3.2 Male Junior Members who hold a handicap of 19.9 or less and female Junior Members who hold a handicap of 39.9 or less in any year shall be eligible to transfer to Junior Qualified membership.
- 12.3.3 Junior Academy members who will be age 11 or over on 1st January in any year may transfer to Junior Membership at the discretion of the Junior Convenors.
- 12.3.4 Junior Cadet Members who will be age 9 or over on 1st January in any year may transfer to Junior Academy membership at the discretion of the Junior Convenors.

13 TEMPORARY JUNIOR MEMBERS

The Main Committee may, from time to time, elect Temporary Junior Members, provided the total of such members does not exceed twenty. Any person so elected shall be a Temporary Junior Member from year to year, subject to Main Committee approval, but shall not exceed three years and shall cease at the end of the subscription year during which he or she reaches 18 years of age. At any time after two years of Temporary Junior Membership, such persons may apply for transfer to Junior Membership.

26 POLICY STATEMENT – YOUNG MEMBERS

The Club is fully committed to safeguarding the well-being of its members. Every individual in golf should at all times, show respect and understanding for members rights, safety and welfare and conduct themselves in a way that reflects the principles of the Club and the guidelines contained in the Club's Code of Ethics relating to Junior Members. In working with young people in golf the Club's first priority is the welfare of the young people and it is committed to providing an environment that will allow participants to perform to the best of their ability, free from bullying and intimidation

BYE-LAWS

1 JUNIORS

- (a)** Juniors may play Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, Friday and Sunday
- (b)** Qualified Juniors aged 15 or over may play in Saturday competitions with access to the timesheet from noon 3 days in advance of the competition. They may also play in Wednesday competitions.
- (c)** Qualified Juniors aged under 15 may play in competition on Sunday with access to Sunday competition timesheet available 3 days in advance.
- (d)** Juniors may invite guests, either other Juniors or adult guests on Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday.
- (e)** Junior members, unless categorised as Qualified Juniors, have no access to the golf course on Wednesdays or Saturdays.
- (f)** Junior members who do not hold an official handicap are not permitted to play on the course without being accompanied by another member who holds an official handicap.
- (g)** Junior Qualified members may play a general round on Saturdays after 5.30pm.
- (h)** Junior members, unless Qualified, are not allowed play on the course on Saturday except after 5.30 and then only with a parent.

2 VISITORS

- (d)** Junior Members may introduce Junior Members of another Golf Club on Mondays, Tuesdays, Thursdays or Fridays at a reduced Green Fee which will be displayed on the Club Notice Board. Their guests must have a CDH number recorded in the Green Fee book and hold a current handicap.
- (e)** Members may bring their guests into the Clubhouse on the understanding that they will be personally responsible for them and their expenses.

6 DRESS

For the full enjoyment of the game and in order to preserve and maintain traditional standards, the Main Committee may lay down regulations for dress both on the Course and in the Clubhouse. Such regulations will be displayed on the Club Notice Board and shall be observed by both Members and visitors

7 MISCELLANEOUS

- (a)** Children under 11 years of age, when in the Clubhouse or on the Course, must be accompanied by an adult or responsible member of their family.
- (g)** Calls to and from mobile phones are not permitted in the Clubhouse except downstairs. Members may carry mobile phones on the course provided they are turned to silent or vibration and only used in an emergency.

In addition to the above Rules & Bye-Laws

1. Junior members who do not hold an official handicap are encouraged to contact one of the Junior Convenors or attend the Club on a Sunday afternoon at 3pm. The Convenors will facilitate the marking of cards necessary to gain a handicap.
2. Junior members should always be aware (by checking the timesheet) whether there is a match being played either before or after them. They should always give way to a match by marking their ball and standing well off the fairway. They should not have to be requested to let either a Club or Inter-Club a match through.
3. Juniors should carry sand bags on the course, replace divots with sand and always repair pitch marks on the green.
